

PARAMEDIC FACT SHEET

The first step in becoming a paramedic is to apply to Columbus State Community College and complete the College Entrance Exam. Next you will need to take EMS 1860 – Emergency Medical Technician Course and successfully pass the National Registry exam in order to become an Ohio Certified EMT (if you haven't already done so). From there you will take the Paramedic Prep Course (Note: a 4 CR hour college level anatomy, physiology or pathophysiology course may be used in lieu of our Paramedic Prep Course). There is an application for the Paramedic Program and specific deadlines for each cohort. We accept applications year-round. Applications may be located at:

During the application process, you will need to schedule and compete the FISDAP Paramedic Entrance Exam. This exam covers math skills, reading comprehension, vocabulary & grammar, biology, anatomy & physiology, chemistry and a learning style profile. A study guide link is provided on our EMS website at www.cscc.edu/ems in the admissions link.

Paramedic students will be required to complete a health record form specifically for the Paramedic Program. This health record must be completed/submitted prior to the start of the second semester of the program. This form can be found on our website or by going to

http://www.cscc.edu/resources/media/services/pdf/health/EMS %20Paramedic.pdf. We highly recommend you start this process early. Note that our hospital and field clinical partners require this completed health record and its content including annual flu vaccinations and COVID vaccinations prior to clinical placement.

Our 30-credit hour (4 semester) Paramedic Program requires a minimum time commitment of 30 clock hours per week. This is divided amongst classroom, skills lab, hospital, and field clinical experiences. This does not include homework or time for studying.

Students who wish to start the Paramedic Program in the Autumn will typically attend classes in the morning. Students who select a Spring start typically have classes in the afternoon. This is subject to change based on instructor availability and student demand.
