Fast Facts about Real Estate

- **What is the cost?** Columbus State tuition and fee information is available on our website: <https://www.csc.edu/academics/tuition-and-fees/>
- **How many courses are needed to sit for the Ohio Salesperson's Exam?** The four classes to the Ohio Real Estate Exam are a total of ten credit hours.
- **What are the classes that are needed to sit for the Salesperson's Exam?** Real Estate Principles and Practices, Real Estate Law, Real Estate Finance, and Real Estate Appraisal. Taking these classes, you will earn The Pre-Licensure Certificate.
- **When are the classes?** The classes are offered each semester. Classes are offered days, evenings, and online. Check the schedule on the CSCC Website for availability.
- **Can the four classes be taken together?** The four classes can be completed in one semester.
- **How to register for the classes?** Once accepted for admission, an individual needs to prove college readiness by taking the College Placement exam or provide transcripts showing proof of college-level Math and English. The Columbus State website can guide students through the admissions and registration process.
- **What Real Estate course(s) does Columbus State offer beyond the Salesperson courses?** There is an Associate's Degree in Real Estate (61 Credit Hours). There is also the Real Estate Professional Certificate (16 Credit Hours), the Real Estate Property Management Certificate (27 Credit Hours), and the Pre-Broker Certificate (22 Credit Hours).
