Avoid Procrastination-Don't wait until the last minute to review your semester notes, quizzes, and exams.


Use the month of April to organize and review your semester's notes, quizzes, and exams from each course.

I hope you are doing well! My name is Dr. Stephanie Clemons and I serve as the assistant director of the Student Advocacy Center here at Columbus State Community College. Part of my work involves providing support services for Columbus State parenting students with funding made available through the U.S. Department of Education Child Care Access Means Parents in School (CCAMPIS) grant. In collaboration with the newly renovated campus childcare facility, The Center for Early Learning at Columbus State, this grant will also provide vouchers to enrolled Columbus State students to help pay for childcare for your child(ren). We are extremely excited to open the Center soon and welcome your children to campus!

We have received your name from Head Start as a family with interest in enrolling your child(ren) at The Center for Early Learning at Columbus State when it opens. I am happy to serve as your point of contact for all things related to our newly established CCAMPIS childcare voucher program, which will assist in paying your childcare expenses at the Center. Students taking classes at Columbus State have priority for enrollment at the Center, so we're reaching out to establish a contact list to send you updates on the opening of the Center and to provide information about how to apply for a CCAMPIS childcare youcher.

To be eligible to receive a CCAMPIS childcare voucher, you must provide proof of:

Course enrollment at Columbus State. 2023-2024 Pell eligibility from your FAFSA. Head Start eligibility. Publicly Funded Child Care eligibility.

Click the links above to learn more about Head Start and Publicly Funded Child Care. Columbus State has a DJFS representative who works with enrolled students who live in Franklin County to determine your eligibility for Publicly Funded Child Care and to process your application. You can schedule a 30-minute phone appointment with our DJFS representative here.

Please note: if you are not a Franklin County resident, you will need to consult with your county-specific Department of Job and Family Services office to determine eligibility and to apply for Publicly Funded Child Care. The Columbus State DJFS representative can only work with students who live in Franklin County.

Your success at Columbus State as a parenting student is important to us. It truly takes a village to both raise a child and to support that child's parent. While I don't have any details about the opening of The Center for Early Learning at Columbus State, I am more than happy to answer any questions you may have about the CCAMPIS childcare voucher program or about scheduling an appointment with our Franklin County dedicated DJFS representatives. Take good care of yourself and your family!


