The Fire Science Technology at Columbus State Community College offers two Associate Degree programs:

In addition we offer training for Professional Firefighter I & II certification. This is the course often referred to as “the 240 class” (240 hrs of training) and is offered Autumn, Spring and Summer Semesters.

These courses, which are taken concurrently, consist of all the performance and knowledge objectives in the current NFPA Standard 1001 for Firefighter I and II including but not limited to: fire department organization, safety, fire alarm, fire behavior, extinguishers, ropes, ladders, hose streams, fire control, salvage and rescue. This course is required for full-time firefighters. The content of these courses will enable students to obtain State of Ohio certification for Firefighter I & II levels (minimum 260 hour firefighter course) upon successful completion of the State of Ohio FF I & II exam.

By State of Ohio regulation, you **MUST** attend 100% of the course hours. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

** Lab fee includes rental of SCBA, bunker coat and pants, helmet, equipment maintenance, engine fuel, etc.. **You must supply your own protective hood, fire boots, and fire gloves. all of which must meet current NFPA standards.** (Approx. Cost \$250.00) Information about this equipment will be sent to you once you are registered to take this class.
