WHAT ARE THE ACCEPTED FORMS OF PAYMENT FOR MY \$50.00 FEE?

We accept cash, check or money order. Checks or money orders must be written out to 'Columbus State Leadership Society'.

WHERE DO I BRING ALL MY APPLICATION MATERIALS?

A completed application and a \$50.00 membership fee must be physically turned in at the Student Engagement and Leadership (SEaL) offices located in Nestor Hall, room 116 by 5:00 p.m. on the due date. Partial and/or late applications will not be accepted or reviewed.

WHEN WILL I KNOW IF I WAS ACCEPTED?

All students will receive an application confirmation. This generally happens early to mid-February. All applicants will receive notice of their application status and those accepted will receive further information to prepare for the "Launch Day".
