

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How long does this take and when can I get my GED?

The length of the program varies from student to student. Your score on the TABE® will determine how many classes you need and how long the program will take.

2. How old do I have to be to participate in the program?

You must be 14 or older to take GED classes at Columbus State.

3. Are GED classes free?

No. The cost of GED classes range from \$99 to \$149 per class. Payment must be made at the time of registration. Financial assistance/payment plan is not available.

4. Can I receive financial aid?

Federal financial aid is not available nor can it be used to pay for non-credit classes.

5. I had an IEP in school. Does that count here?

Yes, but you must first register with Disability Services. For more information, contact 614-287-2570.

6. Where do I take the GED?

You will need to go to GED.com to create an account and register for the test.

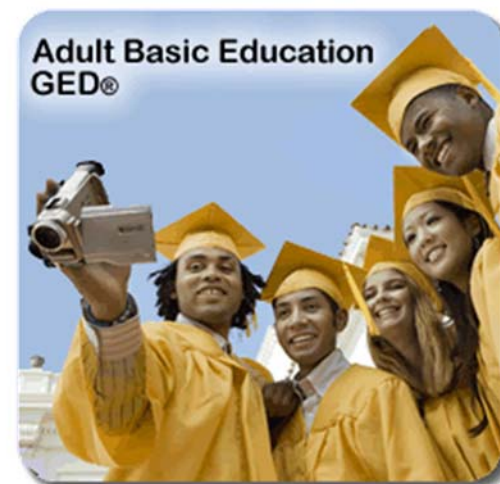
Our courses can be customized to meet particular needs or business focus. They can be held at a company's preferred training site or any of our campuses and regional centers.

How to register for GED classes:

Step 1

Complete TABE® placement test

- The fee for the placement test is **\$15** payable by **check or money order only**.

We do not accept cash.

- You will need to bring a government-issued photo ID.

Upon completion of the TABE® assessment, you will be provided with a list of the courses that match your academic skill level.

Step 2

Register for classes
