

Create An FSA ID Worksheet

Step 1. Create a SAVE KEY. You can use the SAVE KEY to go back onto your FAFSA and make corrections. The SAVE KEY also allows you to share access to your application or correction if your parent needs to add their parental information or sign your FAFSA electronically.

The **SAVE KEY** must be between 4 and 8 characters long. You can use any combination of numbers and / or uppercase and lowercase letters. For example, the save key "Student2" is different than the save key "sTuDeNt2." Avoid using personal identifiers (for example, first name, last name, or date of birth) and simple save keys such as "1234" or "aaaa."

Step 2. Students must create a **Username**

NOTE: Parents of dependents students must create their own FSA ID to sign the student FAFSA electronically. Parents who are students themselves may already have an FSA ID#. Parents will use their own FSA ID# to sign a dependent student FAFSA electronically.

Step 3. Open up your own email in a separate window and keep it open. You will receive an email confirmation giving you a six-digit numeric **Secure Code** later on in the process. You will received the **Secure Code** when you reach **STEP 11** below.

Begin creating your FSA ID by answering the **Step 3** questions below then click on the "**Create An FSA ID**" tab.

Step 4. Open up the FSA ID website in a new page by typing www.fsaaid.ed.gov in the address bar.

Password Hint: Your password must contain (8-30 characters in length) at least three (3) of the following: **numbers, lower case letters, upper case letters and may include non-alpha numeric special characters.** You will be alerted when your password meets all criteria, then you will be required to enter it a second time.

Step 5. Check the box next to "**I am 13 years of age or older**" if you are at least 13 years old or older." Click **CONTINUE**

Step 6. One parent should complete a **Create An FSA ID# Worksheet** with their information. Students should complete a **Create An FSA ID# Worksheet** with their information.

1. Social Security Number (As it appears on your Social Security Card)
2. Date of Birth
3. First Name, Middle Initial, Last Name (As it appears on your Social Security Card)

Step 10. Accept the terms and conditions by checking (✓) the "**I certify that the above information is correct and accept the terms and conditions**" box.

Step 11. An email should have just been sent to the email address that you entered in STEP 4 above giving you a six-digit numeric secure code that you will need to type in the "**Secure Code**" box on the FAFSA form. Look at your email and get your secure code. NOTE: The secure code is "case sensitive." Check your "JUNK" folder if you don't see an email with your Secure Code.
