Tuberculosis Testing
A TB Skin Test is required annually to participate in health related programs. This consists of a small needle being used to put some testing material, called tuberculin, under the skin. In 2-3 days, you return to the health care worker who will check to see if there is a reaction to the test. Tb tine tests are not acceptable per state regulations. <u>If the student recently received an MMR or varicella vaccine</u> , the tuberculosis test must be postponed until at least four to six weeks after the MMR.
