Toward a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education (BSED)

EARLY CHILDHOOD MAJOR LEADING TO OHIO LICENSURE IN GRADES PreK – 3

Note: This advising guide is designed for recent graduates and current students in Columbus State Community College's Associate Degree program in Early Childhood Development. This is NOT an official transfer document but a support piece to help plan and pace a program of study. Once you have been accepted into AU and the Schar College of Education, a formal request for transfer credits will be submitted to the Registrar's Office.

Step 1: Complete your associate degree in Early Childhood Development at CSCC, including *Student Teaching* and *Practicum*. Many of your degree requirements will transfer toward AU's institutional and major requirements. See CSCC or AU representatives for current list of transferable courses.

Step 2: Take additional coursework at CSCC that fulfills AU's institutional and major requirements. This can be done with careful planning during your CSCC program by choosing the right electives or taking CSCC courses while you are enrolled in AU's Bachelor's-Completion Program.

Step 3: Complete at least 60 semester hours at AU Columbus Center or a four-year accredited university with at least 32 hours completed at AU. See "Final Notes" on p.2 for additional stipulations.

FINAL NOTES: In order to receive a BSED in Early Childhood or Early Childhood Intervention Specialist, the student must complete 128 semester hours of coursework. This total includes transferable hours from the associate degree program as well as additional coursework transferred in as part of Step 2, above. At least 60 semester hours must be earned at a four-year accredited, degree-granting college or university with at least 32 semester hours completed at AU. At least one-half of the student's major requirements must be completed at AU. The last 16 semester hours must be completed at AU.
