Setting Up Your CSCC Username & Password

- Your **username is a combination** of the first letter of your first name, your last name, and possibly a number.
 - Example: jsmith888
- Your **username** is **your email** without the @student.cscc.edu, so if you know your email, you know your username!
- Your username is not the same as your Cougar ID number.
 - Username Example: jsmith888
 - Cougar ID Example: 1987654


Verifying Your Class Schedule



Follow these steps to look up your schedule:

- 1.Go to the Columbus State website: cscc.edu.
- 2. Click **CougarWeb** in the top, right corner and log in.
- 3. Click the **Academics symbol** on the left.
- 4. Click Add & Drop Classes/View Schedule.
- *Please note: some online courses may require on-campus exams.

If your schedule is not correct, contact your advisor ASAP!






Obtaining Books & Access Codes

Accessing Blackboard

What is it?

Blackboard is Columbus State's Learning Management System (similar to Google Classroom)

How do I access it?

Go to the Columbus State website and click on Blackboard in the top, right corner. Log in with your CSCC username and password.

What is it used for?

Blackboard is where you'll find everything you need for your class:

- -course syllabus
- -class announcements
- -lecture notes
- -assignment details

How do I get help using it?

CSCC provides Blackboard labs & drop-in help sessions at the beginning of each semester.

When will I see my classes?

Courses will typically appear in Blackboard **3-4 days before the semester begins**. Get familiar with the Blackboard for each class.

Online Orientation

Completing the online orientation is highly encouraged! It includes a toolbox full of **helpful CSCC resources** you can use.

Download the Academic Calendar
