

Earn College Credit with College Credit Plus

Through the College Credit Plus (CCP) Program, students in grades 7-12 can take college courses through Columbus State Community College to earn free college credit and fulfill their high school graduation requirements simultaneously. College courses not only give students the advantage of learning how to meet a college-level standard of academic rigor, they also help offset the cost and time it takes to earn a college degree.

Benefits of college courses through CCP:

- Eligible college classes are offered tuition-free for students
- Students earn college credit while also satisfying high school graduation requirements
- College courses let students expand their academics beyond the traditional high school curriculum



Get Started

Enrolling in college courses at Columbus State starts with an easy application. Our team is here to help you navigate the process.

- 1. Submit your letter of intent to your high school by **April 1st**
- 2. Apply at cscc.edu/ccpapp
- 3. Complete required forms:

4. Meet with your school counselor or CCP advisor to register for classes. You cannot register for classes on your own. Check for registration opening dates at cscc.edu/academics/calendar/





Eligibility

To be eligible for College Credit Plus, new students must meet one of the following criteria:

- Have a cumulative unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Achieve eligible scores on approved assessment exam: ACT, SAT, Accuplacer
