WHY BE A PART OF SNA?

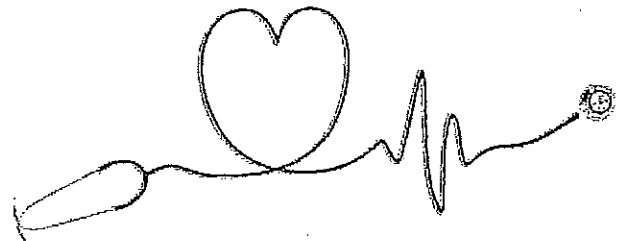
- You get the opportunity to make a difference in the Columbus community
