



Train-the-Trainer Spring 2019

This two credit hour Train-The-Trainer Program (TTTP) will prepare qualified nurses to teach and/or coordinate Nurse Aide Training Programs in Ohio. In addition, this program is Ohio Department of Health approved and meets all standards defined by the Ohio Administrative Code. According to the rules of the Ohio Board of Nursing, credit hours from this course can be used for continuing education credits.

Note: 1 semester credit hour = 15 contact hours

Who is Eligible?

For Primary Instructor:

- RNs or LPNs with an active Ohio License
- RNs with two year's experience as a RN caring for the elderly or chronically ill
- LPNs with two years' experience as a LPN working in a LTCF

For Program Coordinators:

- RNs must have two years experience as an RN
- RNs must have one year experience as a RN in a LTCF
