Fast Facts about Real Estate



Thank you for your interest in the Columbus State Real Estate Program!

- **What is the cost?** Tuition is \$152.93 per credit hour for Ohio residents.
- **How many courses are needed to sit for the Agent's Exam?** The four classes to take the Real Estate Agent Exam are a total of ten credit hours.
- **When are the classes?** Classes are offered each semester. Classes are offered days, nights, online and weekends at the Columbus campus and evenings at select regional centers.
- **Can the four "Agent Exam" classes be taken together?** All four classes can be finished in one semester.
- **Are the classes online?** Per Ohio law, the four classes (for the Agent's Exam) can now be offered online. Check the schedule on the CSCC website for availability.
- **How do I register?** Once accepted for admission, an individual needs to prove college readiness by taking the College Placement exam or providing transcripts showing proof of college level math and English. The Columbus State website can guide you: <http://www.cscce.edu/admissions/>
- **What Real Estate course(s) do you offer beyond the four "Agent Exam" courses?** Columbus State Community College offers a complete Associate's Degree in Real Estate (60 credit hours), along with certifications in Real Estate Professional (16 credit hours), and Real Estate Property Management (27 hours). Many of these classes are offered online. Students may qualify for financial aid.
