

Advanced Addiction Studies Certificate 2018–2019

DESCRIPTION:

This 29-hour program is for students with an Associate degree in a related field or a Bachelor's or a Master's degree in any field. Completion of this certificate meets the acceptable chemical dependency education hours required for licensure in the State of Ohio. Students participate in up to two semesters of supervised clinical practicum in the addictions field. For more information, see cscc.edu/sahs.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students must interview with Advanced Certificate Coordinator to verify eligibility. Students must provide official transcripts verifying prior college degree. In addition, students must complete the background check process.

ONGOING REQUIREMENTS:

Students must adhere to the Professional Expectations and the Code of Conduct. Students participate in two semesters of practicum at a local addictions-related site. Students are encouraged to verify summer term financial aid eligibility. Students must maintain a 2.5 grade point average.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES UPON COMPLETION OF CERTIFICATE:

Upon completion of the certificate, students can work in a variety of addictions-related treatment services. This certificate meets the Ohio Chemical Dependency Professional Board's Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselor addictions specific content. Students may also be eligible to apply for the Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, Marriage and Family Therapist Board's Social Work Assistant Registration.
