



Business Management Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) 2018–2019

DESCRIPTION:

The Business Management A.A.S. is a foundational degree in business that offers a strong overview of business functions and opportunities to specialize in certificate areas. In a dynamic active learning environment that incorporates theory and practice, students will develop a strong background in the functional areas of business. Most courses will incorporate team projects, presentations, and case analysis to enhance student's writing and critical thinking skills as well as their business acumen.

Classes are taught in face to face and distance learning formats. Most distance learning courses require web conferencing. Upon completion, students will be able to begin a career in an entry level management position, advance with their current employer, or continue to pursue a Bachelor degree at a transfer institution. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students must have a high school diploma or GED equivalency.

ONGOING REQUIREMENTS:

Students must maintain the minimum overall GPA required by the College.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES:

Career:

Completion of the Business Management degree will allow students to pursue positions managing people and organizational resources in manufacturing, service, government, and small business enterprises. Student may serve in business support functions or line management positions. Some common job titles for Associate degree candidates include line supervisor/manager, distribution supervisor/manager, customer service representative/manager, production coordinator/analyst, project coordinator/analyst, retail or restaurant supervisor/manager, collections representative/manager, or inside sales support specialist. Many students use this degree to start their career, as a vehicle for promotion within their current employer, or as the first step toward pursuit of a Bachelor degree in Business.

Transfer:

Graduates are eligible to transfer to the Franklin University 3+1 program leading to Bachelor of Science Degree in several Business specializations, to the Ohio University Program leading to Bachelor of Science in Applied Management or Bachelor of Applied Technical Studies, or to Ohio Dominican University leading to a Bachelor of Science in Business Management. Most transfer paths require a final GPA of 2.0 and conferring of an Associate Degree, and generally additional math courses of college level Algebra or above will be required.
