



## Entrepreneurship Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) 2018–2019

### DESCRIPTION:

The Entrepreneurship A.A.S. is a foundational degree in business that offers a strong overview of business functions and opportunities to specialize in certificate areas. In a dynamic active learning environment that incorporates theory and practice, students will develop a strong background in the functional areas of entrepreneurship.

Most courses will incorporate team projects, presentations, and case analysis to enhance student's writing and critical thinking skills as well as their business acumen. Classes are taught in face-to-face and distance learning formats. Most distance learning courses require web conferencing. Upon completion, students will have the skills sets to advance with their current employer as well as start or expand their own small business. ### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

This is a non-selective, open-admission program. Students must have a high school diploma or GED equivalency.

### ONGOING REQUIREMENTS:

Students must maintain minimum overall GPA required by the College.

### OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES:

#### Career:

Completion of the Entrepreneurship degree will provide students with the knowledge and skill sets to open or expand their own small business in their industry of choice. Some common job titles for AAS degree candidates include owner and manager.

#### Transfer:

Many courses required in the Entrepreneurship A.A.S. are electives or requirements that can be applied to the Business Management AAS degree. BMGT graduates are eligible to transfer to the Franklin University 3+1 program leading to Bachelor of Science Degree in several Business specializations, to the Ohio University Program leading to Bachelor of Science in Applied Management or Bachelor of Applied Technical Studies, or to Ohio Dominican University leading to a Bachelor of Science in Business Management.

Most transfer paths require a final GPA of 2.0 and conferring of an Associate Degree, and generally additional math courses of college level Algebra or above will be required.
