



## Digital Video and Sound Certificate

### 2018–2019

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Understanding how to successfully communicate with current technology is a necessary competence in the ever-changing world of digital communication. The Digital Video Production certificate provides students with hands-on comprehensive training in digital media production. Students will develop technical skills in lighting, videography, motion graphics, digital audio, script writing, and video editing. Also, students will learn to integrate graphics, sound, video, animation, text and still images to create any variety of entertainment, motion graphic, and creative video content. To add to their foundation, real world experiences and opportunities will be given to create a working portfolio. In addition to building technical proficiencies, the certificates will provide the essential skills and knowledge needed to obtain entry level jobs in the communication, marketing, or social media industries.

The Digital Video Production Certificate is intended primarily for students who desire to complete or supplement their degree and/or enhance their skill set for current or future employment. Usually the most successful candidate is working with another degree like Photography, Interactive Media, Digital Design, Marketing or Computer Science. Some common job titles include: video editor, social media video producer, video animator, video/after effects specialist, audio/video technician, visual information specialist.
