



Early Childhood Development and Education (ECD) and Administration Certificate

DESCRIPTION:

With completion of 12 credit hours in Early Childhood Development and Education, minimum qualifications to be a childcare administrator by Ohio Child Day Care Licensing Standards will have been met provided the candidate has two years' work experience in group care of young children. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must provide demonstration of two years' work experience in group care of young children.

ONGOING REQUIREMENTS:

Students must maintain a grade of "C" or above in ECDE 1101 and ECDE 1105.

Career:

Upon completion of the ECDE Education and Administration certificate, students are qualified to administer early childhood programs with duties including hiring of staff, working with families, and maintaining licensing requirements.

Transfer:

Courses in the ECDE Education and Administration are the foundational courses in the ECDE A.A.S. degree program.
