



Fire Inspector Certificate

2018–2019

DESCRIPTION:

The Fire Inspector Certificate is designed to meet the prerequisite requirements for eligibility to test in the State of Ohio for Fire Inspector Certification.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Prior to admission into a fire safety inspector course, an individual shall meet all of the following requirements: possess a current Firefighter Certificate (Firefighter I & II) issued under section 4765.55 of the Ohio Revised Code and 4765-20 of the Ohio Administrative Code that is in good standing; shall be employed by one of the following: the Office of the State Fire Marshal, a firefighting agency as defined in division (A)(3) of section 9.60 of the Revised Code, or a private fire company as defined in division (A)(5) of section 9.60 of the Revised Code that is providing fire protection in accordance with division (B), (C), or (D) of section 9.60 of the Revised Code.

ONGOING REQUIREMENTS:

Ohio Department of Public Safety-Division of EMS, continuing education requirements are needed to retain certifications.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES:

Fire Inspectors work in conjunction with the State Fire Marshal inspect buildings to identify potential fire hazards, ensure buildings are equipped with fire control equipment, and recommend actions to bring properties into compliance with appropriate fire codes. They work for urban and rural fire agencies.
