



Health and Safety Training for Hazardous Waste Operations (OSHA 40-Hour HAZWOPER) Certificate

2018–2019

DESCRIPTION:

In this certificate program, students learn the regulations and practices required for working safely in environmental occupations. OSHA requires this certification for employees working at contaminated and hazardous waste sites. For more information, see csc.edu/essh.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

This is a non-selective, open-admission program.

ONGOING REQUIREMENTS:

Full class attendance is required to obtain the credential.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES:

Career:

Students with this certification, particularly those with college degrees, have a distinct advantage in the job market since many jobs in the environmental field require this training. Jobs for those who hold this certification, but do not have a college degree, are usually hands-on.

Transfer:

The Health and Safety Training for Hazardous Waste Operations (OSHA 40 Hour HAZWOPER) Certificate can apply to the A.A.S. degree in Environmental Science, Safety, and Health and to the Occupational Health and Safety Certificate. It is not uncommon for local four-year institutions to grant college credit for this course.
