



Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) Clinical Laboratory Assisting Certificate

2018–2019

DESCRIPTION:

The Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) Clinical Laboratory Assisting Certificate is designed to provide exposure to the clinical laboratory techniques and procedures needed in entry-level laboratory jobs. This certificate can be completed within one semester and can be applied toward an Associate of Applied Science degree in Medical Laboratory Technology or Multi-Skilled Health Technology. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students must place into ENGL 1100 and “No Reading Required” and must have completed BIO 0100 or higher (with a grade of “C” or higher) or placement equivalent.

ONGOING REQUIREMENTS:

Students must earn a “C” or higher in each certificate course for satisfactory performance.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES:

Career:

This certificate prepares students for entry-level clinical laboratory assisting positions.

Transfer:

All certificate courses can be applied toward the MLT.AAS degree. In addition, the MLT Clinical Laboratory Assisting Certificate may fulfill one of the certificate requirements for the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) in Multi-Competency Health. These courses may also be taken as stand-alone courses that meet a professional need or personal interest.
