



Nurse Aide Training Certificate

2018–2019

DESCRIPTION:

The Nurse Aide Training Certificate Program is designed to instruct the student in the knowledge and skills needed to provide basic care for patients in the long-term care setting. Course content emphasizes communication skills, medical asepsis, patient safety, and basic patient care skills. Besides lecture and laboratory experiences, the student will provide patient care in the clinical setting of a long-term care facility. Because this is a skills-based course, classroom, clinical, and laboratory attendance is mandatory.

This course is recognized by the Ohio Department of Health as a State Approved Nurse Aide Course. The student who successfully completes the class with an 80% overall average will receive a “certificate of class completion” and will be eligible to take the state test for nurse aides. This standard is mandated by the Ohio Administrative Code (3701-18-13). For more information, see csc.edu/nursing.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Placement in ENGL 1100; placement into “No Reading Required” OR college transcript with ENGL coursework. Clinical agencies have set requirements for patient safety. Students enrolling in programs with a clinical component will be informed of the specific requirements for health, fingerprinting, and/or drug screening prior to enrollment..
