



Train the Trainer Nurse Aide Certificate

DESCRIPTION:

This certificate/course prepares the qualified nurse to teach, coordinate, and supervise a Nurse Aide Training Program in Ohio.

The course follows state requirements as outlined in the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC 3701-18-14 through 3701-18-21). For more information, see csc.edu/nursing.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Current RN/LPN licensure in Ohio; professional resume; minimum of two years of experience in caring for the elderly or chronically ill; letter of verification documenting employment history.
