

F1 Admissions Checklist

International students intending to study in the United States on an F1 visa have additional admission requirements and must submit supplemental documentation during the admission process. This checklist lists the documents needed to receive a Form I-20 to apply for an F1 visa or transfer to Columbus State from another college or university in the US.

Make sure you have completed the [Standard Application](#) and received a Cougar ID number (student ID) before submitting documents. Your Cougar ID number can be found in the email Columbus State sent to you 1-2 days after you applied to the College.

The International Student Services office (ISS) must receive **all** of the following documents to issue a Form I-20. If you have questions about the documents required, refer to the “Explanation of Documents” on the F1 webpage. After you complete the application, email copies of all documents to istudent@csc.edu. Documents submitted to Columbus State Community College will not be returned.

All F1 applicants must submit the following documents:

1. High School Diploma or Final Examination Results
2. Evidence of Financial Ability
3. Financial Sponsor’s Affidavit of Support
4. Immigration Documents (Passport, visa, I-94, if applicable)
5. English Proficiency Results
6. Personal Data Form

F1 Transfer Students (if you already have an F1 visa and Form I-20 from another school) must submit the following additional documentation:

7. Transfer Eligibility Form
8. Official Transcripts

I certify that I have included the above documentation in my admission package as an international F-1 applicant at Columbus State Community College. I understand that submitting documents after the admission deadline does not guarantee my admission for the semester in which I am applying. I know that any document submitted to CSCC for my admission consideration will not be returned.
