ARE YOU READY?

Eligibility

To be eligible for the program, students must:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Have a final high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.0
- Desire to graduate from Columbus State and Transfer to The Ohio State University
- Priority admissions given to those who meet at least 1 of the following 3 criteria:
 - Demonstrated financial need as determined by FAFSA application
 - Identifies as an underrepresented minority
 - Identifies as a *first-generation college student

Application Steps

To apply for the Columbus State Buckeye Bound Program, complete the following steps:

- Complete the free online application to Columbus State at csc.edu/apply
- Complete placement testing and/or request official ACT/SAT/AP/IB/CLEP scores be sent to the college, as well as submit official transcripts of any previously earned college credit not completed at CSCC
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.ed.gov and add the CSCC school code: 006867
- Complete the Columbus State Buckeye Bound Application **with** an official high school transcript by June 1, 2020
- Submit a 500-word essay in which you define success and the traits you possess that will enhance your educational future.
- Register and attend CSCC New Student Orientation

Program Requirements

To be successful in the program and meet renewal criteria, students must:

- Attend a 1-day C.O.R.E. Early Arrival Program – Invitation sent after acceptance into program
- Enroll in the OSU specific **COLS 1100 course – Completion of COLS is a degree requirement
- Maintain full-time enrollment in autumn and spring semesters. If student drops below full-time, summer enrollment may be required depending on student'
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA and satisfactory academic progress (SAP) towards degree requirements
- Submit Academic Performance Reports provided by OSU liaison
- Attend Monthly Grub Clubs
- Complete Success Activities

* Neither parent earned a bachelor degree

** Students who complete COLS 1100 for Honors, STEM or CSE, will be accommodated.
