DEGREE-TO-DEGREE TRANSFER PROGRAMS

Associate of Science (A.S.) fulfills requirements for the first two years of a Bachelor of Science with guaranteed credit transfer to any Ohio public and many private colleges/universities.

Associate of Arts (A.A.) fulfills requirements for the first two years of a Bachelor of Arts with guaranteed credit transfer to any Ohio public and many private colleges/universities.

CAREER PROGRAMS

Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) prepares students to enter the workforce and provides select transfer options to continue on for a bachelor's degree.

Associate of Technical Studies (A.T.S.) enables a student to design an individualized program of study to fulfill a unique career goal that cannot be met through the completion of any one of the college's technical programs.

Certificates provide credentials in a specific discipline through short-term study (usually 1–2 semesters).

Discover the value of an associate degree.

- Earning an associate degree in two years costs \$10,976.
- You and your Columbus State credits are guaranteed to be accepted at any public Ohio college/university (and many private institutions) when you graduate with an A.A. or A.S.
- Earning an A.A.S. or A.T.S. gives you the skills to enter the job market immediately.
- With the demand for knowledgeable, skilled employees at an all-time high, associate degrees are opening new career doors. Average annual earnings for associate degree holders in Ohio is \$55,700.*
- Some two-year degree holders average annual salaries of \$60,000–\$78,000, including web developers, dental hygienists, respiratory therapists, and electro-mechanical engineering technicians.**
- Once employed, you may qualify for tuition benefits from your employer, allowing you to earn a bachelor's degree at no cost to you.

Transfer Options

csc.edu/transfer

- Transfer agreements with 40+ colleges across Ohio (all public institutions and numerous private colleges/universities).
 - 2+2 agreements (Complete your first two years at Columbus State, then two final years at a four-year college/university)
 - 3+1 agreements (Complete your first three years at Columbus State, then one final year at a four-year college/university)
- Students who start at community colleges and transfer to complete a bachelor's degree graduate at a higher rate (73%) than students who start at a four-year institution (63%).
- Faculty at our four-year partner schools say Columbus State graduates are well prepared to succeed at their institutions.

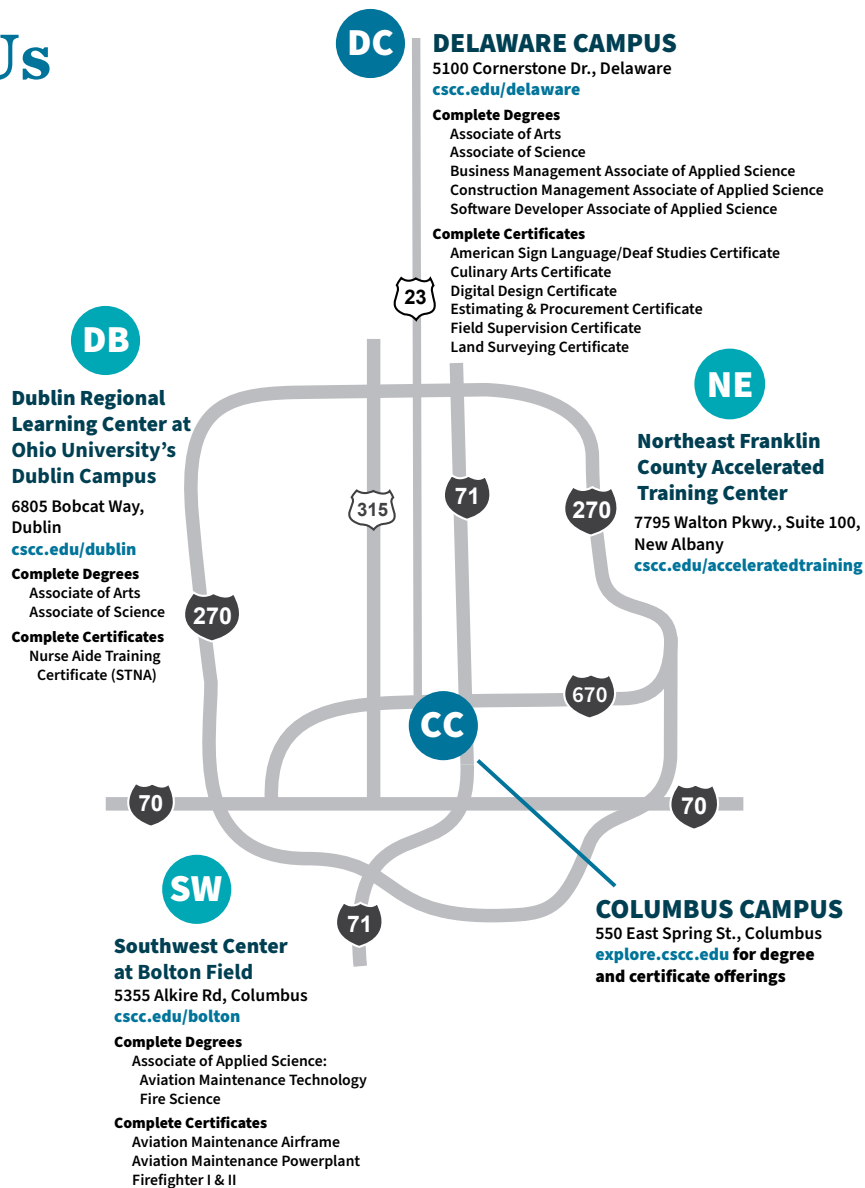
