- **CSCC General Education Requirements:** Students should choose the General Education courses for the AA degree in consultation with their academic and faculty advisors.
- **CSCC Degree Plan:** This Sample Graduation Plan was created with the assumption that students would complete the English Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major before transferring into the stated bachelor's degree. Completing the general Associate of Arts degree is also an option and this document can still be used for degree planning. If you have questions, contact a Columbus State Arts and Sciences Academic Advisor and an advisor at The Ohio State University.

- **Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathway:** Upon completion of this degree, students will earn the designation on their transcript “Ohio Guarantee Transfer Pathway”. The Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways (OGTPs) are designed to provide a clearer path to degree completion for students pursuing associate degrees who plan to transfer to an Ohio public university to complete their bachelor’s degree. The OGTPs also constitute an agreement between public community colleges and universities confirming that community college courses meet major preparation requirements and will be counted and applied toward the bachelor’s degree. Students still must meet all university program admission requirements for the English department and The Ohio State University as listed below.
- **AA Degree and Ohio Transfer 36:** Students who complete the AA degree at Columbus State earn the Ohio Transfer 36 (formerly the Ohio Transfer Module). OSU requires students to complete the Ohio Transfer 36 and the AA degree if they wish to waive the OSU GE Foundations, Open Theme, and Bookend (Launch & Reflection Seminars until Summer 24) requirements for the OSU degree. **If a student does not complete the AA degree and/or the Ohio Transfer 36, they will need to take additional general education course work at OSU to earn the degree.**
- **OSU General Education Requirements:** How a student completes these requirements will vary, depending on how he or she chose to complete the General Education requirements at Columbus State. Any General Education requirements not completed at Columbus State will need to be completed at Ohio State. Students may be required to take a specialized “Bookend” seminar for transfer students at OSU even if they have completed the AA degree and the OT-36. Elective course work, if selected appropriately, can be used to pursue a minor. Students should consult with an academic advisor in the department of the intended major to discuss optimal course selections for General Education, effective choice of electives, and appropriate course selections in the major. - All programs in the College of the Arts and Sciences require a minimum of 121 semester hours, including a minimum of 39 hours at or above the 3000 level.
- ****English Major: Pre-Education Concentration:** Students must complete ENGL 2201; ENGL 2290; ENGL 2202 or 2291 with a grade of C or higher for the courses to apply to the English major: Pre-Education concentration at OSU. The OSU English Major requires 39 credit hours total. The Pre-Education concentration is designed to prepare students for post-baccalaureate education licensure programs for Integrated Language Arts Education. Students are encouraged to also complete additional courses in English, education, and psychology to prepare for this future course work. One of these courses is equivalent to CSCC’s PSY 2551: Adolescent Psychology (must complete PSY 1100 first). Courses to complete the concentration will be chosen in conjunction with your OSU academic advisor.

Suggested Courses to Complete for OSU’s General Education Requirement (new -2022) and Requirements for the Associate of Arts Degree at Columbus State

Intermediate Composition

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one course from ENGL 2367, 2467, 2567, 2667, or 2767.

Historical Study

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one Historical Study course. Any course from the list on the AA English Bachelor’s Degree Transfer major plan of study can be chosen for this requirement.

Social Science

For the AA degree and the OT-36, two social science courses are required from two different departments. Any two courses from two different departments on the AA English Bachelor’s Degree Transfer Major plan of study may be chosen. Students may choose to complete PSY 1100 here to prepare for future course work in education/psychology for educational licensure.

Natural Science

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must take two science courses. At least one course must have a lab. OSU requires a lab course for the GE Foundations: Natural Science requirement. The second science course may be a lab or a non-lab course and may be selected from the list on the AA English Bachelor’s Degree Plan of Study.

Cultures & Ideas/Visual & Performing Arts

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one course from Cultures & Ideas/Visual and Performing Arts. Any course listed in these categories from the AA English Bachelor’s Degree Transfer Major plan of study may be chosen.

OT-36 Exploration

To earn the AA degree and the OT-36, Students must complete three additional courses from Social Science, Literature/Cultures and Ideas/Visual and Performing Arts, and Historical Study categories on the AA plan of study. It is

recommended that students complete CLAS 1222 as one of their three course, but it is not required. If students wish to prepare for further work in education, they can complete PSY 2551 for one of these courses.

Foreign Language

For the OSU degree, students must complete one foreign language at the 1103 level. Any language from the list on the AA English Bachelor's Degree Transfer major plan of study can be chosen for this requirement except for Arabic and Japanese. Students selecting Chinese for this requirement will need to complete CHIN 1103 at OSU.
