- **CSCC General Education Requirements:** Students should choose the General Education courses for the AA degree in consultation with their academic and faculty advisors.
- **CSCC Degree Plan:** This Sample Graduation Plan was created using the general plan of study for the Columbus State Associate of Arts degree. Students who are following a specific Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major at Columbus State may utilize this plan for the purposes of transfer and degree planning, but should note that additional course work may be necessary to complete the Columbus State Associate of Arts Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major beyond what is required for the Bachelor of Arts degree- Arts Management major at OSU. Additional course work completed as part of Columbus State's Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major may be applied as electives or where appropriate, course work

toward the major/minor at OSU.

- **AA Degree and Ohio Transfer 36:** Students who complete the AA degree at Columbus State earn the Ohio Transfer 36 (formerly the Ohio Transfer Module). OSU requires students to complete the Ohio Transfer 36 and/or the AA degree to fulfill the OSU General Education Foundations, Open Choice Theme, and Bookend (Launch & Reflection Seminars) requirements for the OSU degree. **If a student does not complete the AA degree and/or the Ohio Transfer 36, they will need to take additional general education course work at OSU to earn the degree.**
- **OSU General Education Requirements:** How a student completes these requirements will vary, depending on how he or she chose to complete the General Education requirements at Columbus State. Students may not overlap GE and major courses. If a course can count for the major, a different course must be completed for the GE requirement. Any General Education requirements not completed at Columbus State will need to be completed at Ohio State. Students may be required to take a specialized “Bookend” seminar for transfer students at OSU even if they have completed the AA degree and the OT-36. Elective course work, if selected appropriately, can be used to pursue a minor. Students should consult with an academic advisor in the department of the intended major to discuss optimal course selections for General Education, effective choice of electives, and appropriate course selections in the major. - All programs in the College of Arts and Sciences require a minimum of 121 semester hours, including a minimum of 39 hours at or above the 3000 level.
- ****OSU Arts Management Major:** The Arts Management major consists of a minimum of 36 credit hours, not including 12 credit hours of required prerequisite courses (ECON 2200 [ECON 2200 at CSCC], MATH 1130 [MATH 1130 at CSCC], BUSMHR 2500, CSE 1110). All prerequisite courses must be completed before the major can be officially declared and ARTEDUC 2100 registered. All courses completed for the prerequisites and major must have a grade of C or higher. It is recommended that students complete ACCT 1211 and 1212 at CSCC. If students do not complete both courses at CSCC, they will have to take ACCTMIS 2000: Foundations of Accounting at OSU, which is a more difficult course. For the major, students will complete at least three core courses, five advanced major electives, a capstone course, and one applied course. Students should consult with the Arts Management major advisor to select courses that will satisfy the major requirements. Suggested Courses to Complete for OSU’s General Education Requirement (new -2022) and Requirements for the Associate of Arts Degree at Columbus State

Intermediate Composition

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one course from ENGL 2367, 2467, 2567, 2667, or 2767.

Historical Study

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one Historical Study course. Any course from the list on the AA plan of study can be chosen for this requirement

Literature/Cultures & Ideas/Visual & Performing Arts

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one Literature/Cultures & Ideas/Visual & Performing Arts course. Any course from the list on the AA plan of study can be chosen for this requirement

Natural Science

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must take two science courses. At least one course must have a lab. OSU requires at least one laboratory course. The second science course may be a lab or a non-lab course and may be selected from the list on the AA Plan of Study.

Social & Behavioral Science

For this degree, ECON 2200 will satisfy one of the two required Social & Behavioral Science required courses for the AA degree and the OT-36. A second course not in the ECON department must be chosen from the AA Plan of Study.

OT-36 Exploration

To earn the AA degree and the OT-36, Students must complete at least three additional courses from Social Science, Literature/Cultures and Ideas/Visual and Performing Arts, and Historical Study categories on the AA plan of study
