- **CSCC General Education Requirements:** Students should choose the General Education courses toward the AA degree in consultation with their academic advisors. See list after OSU notes for specific CSCC courses that satisfy OSU requirements.
- **CSCC Degree Plan:** This Sample Graduation Plan was created with the assumption that students would complete all course work for the AA Business Transfer Pathway and transfer into the stated bachelor’s degree major/program. Students may complete the general Associate of Arts degree and still utilize this plan for the purposes of transfer and

degree completion. These students are strongly encouraged to meet with their completion academic advisors in FCOB Academic Advising and their counterparts at OSU.

- **Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathway:** Upon completion of this degree, students will earn the designation on their transcript “Ohio Guarantee Transfer Pathway”. The Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways (OGTPs) are designed to provide a clearer path to degree completion for students pursuing associate degrees who plan to transfer to an Ohio public university to complete their bachelor’s degree. The OGTPs also constitute an agreement between public community colleges and universities confirming that community college courses meet major preparation requirements and will be counted and applied toward the bachelor’s degree. Students still must meet all university program admission requirements for the Fisher College of Business and The Ohio State University as listed below.
- **AA Degree and Ohio Transfer 36:** Students who complete the AA degree at Columbus State earn the Ohio Transfer 36 (formerly the Ohio Transfer Module). OSU requires students to complete the Ohio Transfer 36 and/or the AS degree to fulfill the OSU General Education Foundations, and Open Choice Theme requirements for the OSU degree. **If a student does not complete the AA degree and/or the Ohio Transfer 36, they will need to take additional general education course work at OSU to earn the degree.**
- **OSU General Education Requirements:** Any General Education requirements not completed at Columbus State will be completed at Ohio State. Students with questions prior to admission to the Fisher College of Business should consult an advisor via FCOB-transfer@osu.edu
- **This plan assumes student is eligible for direct admission to Fisher.** Please see the next page for direct admission criteria for eligibility. If a student is NOT eligible, it will extend their time to graduation.
- The number of major specialization courses may vary and the number of electives may vary. Students should consult with an FCOB academic advisor upon enrollment to determine an accurate graduation plan that take both items into account.
- Course availability is not guaranteed for the term course as shown in this plan. Time to degree could be affected by the inability to register for the necessary major specialization courses in the sequence order necessary.
- All courses that are part of the Transfer Assurance Guide (TAG) as defined by the Ohio Department of Higher Education will be accepted and applied toward the required degree areas.
- All BSBA programs in Fisher require a minimum of 121 credit hours to graduate.
- **All students must apply and be accepted to The Ohio State University.** Student should indicate “Business” or one of the Fisher specializations on the OSU application as the desired major. There is no separate application to the Fisher College of Business.

Transfer students must meet all criteria for direct admission to be considered. Courses in progress are not considered.

- **Criteria for Direct Admission Review:**
 - All final transcripts must be received by the OSU Office of Admissions. It is the student’s responsibility to ensure that all transcripts have been sent and are received by OSU, including AP and IB official score reports, official transcripts from all colleges attending, official CLEP scores, etc.
 - Have transfer credit officially evaluated and posted for Math 1131 or Math 1151 with a grade of C or better.
 - Have transfer credit officially evaluated and posted for English 1110 (ENGL 1100) with a grade of C or better.
 - Completion of 26 semester hours of collegiate level coursework POST HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION. No college level credit earned in high school will be counted in this total.
 - Must have a minimum final cumulative GPA of 3.10. If multiple institutions were attended, a merged GPA will be calculated using the grades from all course work completed.
- **Application to the Business Major Program Process**

Students who are **not** eligible for direct admission and begin their studies at OSU in another major program or University Exploration will have to apply to the major program and specialization once the application requirements are met. Admission to the major program and specialization is determined by the available enrollment capacity, size, and quality of the applicant pool and **therefore is not guaranteed**. Application to the major and specialization can be submitted once the following criteria is met:

 - Completion of 26 semester hours of collegiate level coursework

- Completion of a minimum of 12 semester hours at OSU (letter-graded earned hours).
 - Minimum OSU GPA of 3.1 or higher.
 - Completion of ENGL 1110 (ENGL 1100) with a grade of C or higher.
 - Completion of MATH 1131 or 1151 (MATH 1131 or 1151) with a grade of C or higher.
 - Current OSU students apply to the major and specialization by submitting an online application that is made available one month prior to each stated application deadline (Autumn- June 1; Spring- September 15; Summer- January 31).
 - Application to major requirements are subject to change. Students are strongly encouraged to consult with an FCOB academic advisor prior to application to the major.
- **International transfer students** (including DACA students) accepted to OSU must have less than 60 semester hours or the equivalent to be accepted into the Fisher College of Business through direct admission. Students who do not meet Fisher direct admission criteria or who have more than 60 semester hours will be denied admission from FCOB and from the university.
 - **Regional Campus Transfer Student Admission:** Transfer students may seek admission to the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree on Ohio State's regional campuses in Newark, Marion, Mansfield, and Lima. FCOB specializations are not available on the regional campuses. Students receive a general business specialization with their BSBA degree. Regional Transfer Students must meet the direct admission criteria stated below:
 - **Criteria for Direct Admission Review:**
 - All final transcripts must be received by the OSU Office of Admissions. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all transcripts have been sent and are received by OSU, including AP and IB official score reports, official transcripts from all colleges attending, official CLEP scores, etc.
 - Have transfer credit officially evaluated and posted for Math 1131 or Math 1151 with a grade of C or better.
 - Have transfer credit officially evaluated and posted for English 1110 (ENGL 1100) with a grade of C or better.
 - Completion of 26 semester hours of collegiate level coursework POST HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION. No college level credit earned in high school will be counted in this total.
 - Must have a minimum final cumulative GPA of 3.0. If multiple institutions were attended, a merged GPA will be calculated using the grades from all course work completed.

Suggested Courses to Complete for OSU's General Education Requirement and Requirements for the Associate of Arts Degree at Columbus State

Intermediate Composition

For the AA degree, the OT-36, and the degree at OSU, students must complete one course from ENGL 2367, 2467, 2567, 2667, or 2767. This course will count towards the Advanced Writing Literacy requirement for the BSBA at OSU.

Historical Study

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one Historical Study course. Any course from the list on the AA Business plan of study can be chosen for this requirement.

Social Science

For the AA degree, two social science courses are required. The AA Business requires ECON 2200 and this course will be one of the two social science requirements. The second social science course may not be from ECON and must be from a different department and can be selected from the list on the AA Business plan of study.

Natural Science

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must take two science courses. At least one course must have a lab. The second science course may be a lab or a non-lab course and may be selected from the list on the AA Business plan of study.

Literature/Cultures & Ideas/Visual & Performing Arts

For the AA degree and the OT-36, students must complete one course from Literature/Cultures & Ideas/ Visual and Perf. Arts. Any course listed in these categories from the AA Business major plan of study may be chosen.
