- **CSCC General Education Requirements:** Students should choose the General Education courses toward the AA degree in consultation with their academic advisors. See list after UC notes for specific CSCC courses that satisfy UC requirements.
- **CSCC Degree Plan:** This Sample 2+2 Graduation Plan was created with the assumption that students would complete all course work for the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major and transfer into the stated

bachelor's degree major/program. Students may complete the general Associate of Arts degree and still utilize this plan for the purposes of transfer and degree completion. These students are strongly encouraged to meet with their completion academic advisors in Lindner College Advising and their counterparts at UC.

- **Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathway:** Upon completion of this degree, students will earn the designation on their transcript "Ohio Guarantee Transfer Pathway". The Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways (OGTPs) are designed to provide a clearer path to degree completion for students pursuing associate degrees who plan to transfer to an Ohio public university to complete their bachelor's degree. The OGTPs also constitute an agreement between public community colleges and universities confirming that community college courses meet major preparation requirements and will be counted and applied toward the bachelor's degree. Students still must meet all university program admission requirements for the Lindner College of Business and the University of Cincinnati as listed below.
- **AA Degree and Ohio Transfer 36:** Students who complete the AA degree at Columbus State earn the Ohio Transfer 36 (formerly the Ohio Transfer Module). Students who complete the OT-36 will have the UC general education requirement complete. **If a student does not complete the AA degree and/or the Ohio Transfer 36, they will need to take additional general education course work at UC to earn the degree.**
- **UC General Education Requirements:** Any General Education requirements not completed at Columbus State will be completed at the University of Cincinnati. Students with questions prior to admission to the Lindner College of Business and the University of Cincinnati should contact UC Transfer and Transition Advising at transfer@uc.edu
- The number of major specialization courses may vary, and the number of electives may vary. This plan assumes an autumn semester start. Students should consult with a Lindner College academic advisor upon enrollment to determine an accurate graduation plan that take both items into account.
 - Available specializations are Accounting, Business Economics, Information Systems, Insurance & Risk Management, International Business, Marketing, Finance, Operations Management, and Real Estate. Only Marketing and Finance are available completely online. All specializations are available on campus at UC.
- Course availability is not guaranteed for the term course as shown in this plan. Time to degree could be affected by the inability to register for the necessary major specialization courses in the sequence order necessary.
- All BBA programs in Lindner require a minimum of 120 credit hours to graduate.
- Students must earn a 2.5 overall GPA and eligibility for Calculus and/or completion of MATH 1131 or 1151 with the appropriate passing grade (D or higher) to be admitted to the Lindner College of Business at UC.

Suggested Courses to Complete for UC's General Education Requirement and Requirements for the Associate of Arts Degree at Columbus State

Intermediate Composition

For the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer major, the OT-36, and the degree at UC, students must complete one course from ENGL 2367, 2467, 2567, 2667, or 2767.

Historical Study

For the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer major and the OT-36, students must complete one Historical Study course. Any course from the list on the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer major plan of study can be chosen for this requirement.

Social Science

For the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major, two social science courses are required. The AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer major requires ECON 2200 and this course will be one of the two social science requirements. The second social science course may not be from ECON and must be from a different department and can be selected from the list on the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Plan of Study.

Natural Science

For the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major degree and the OT-36, students must take two science courses. At least one course must have a lab. The second science course may be a lab or a non-lab course and may be selected from the list on the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Plan of Study.

Literature/Cultures & Ideas/Visual & Performing Arts

For the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer major and the OT-36, students must complete one course from Literature/Cultures & Ideas/Visual and Performing Arts. Any course listed in these categories from the major plan of study may be chosen.

OT-36 Exploration

For this requirement, students will complete ECON 2201, MATH 1130/1146, and STAT 2430. These courses meet requirements for the AA Business Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major, OT-36, major, and degree requirements at UC. If a student does not need MATH 1130/MATH 1146 due to placement into a higher course, they may need to complete an additional OT-36 course in Social Science, Literature/Cultures & Ideas/Visual & Performing Arts, or Historical Study for this requirement.
