Notes about the Social Work Major

- **Addiction Studies/Advanced Addiction Studies Certificate/Substance Abuse Counseling Certificate:** If students are seeking Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselor III (LCDC) certification in addition to the BSW course work, it is recommended that students complete MULT 2114 to earn the Addiction Studies Certificate at CSCC. In some cases, students may earn the Advanced Addiction Studies Certificate instead, if eligible. Completing this credential at Columbus State combined with the major courses in BOLD above allows students to become eligible for the LCDC III. This course work is not required at either institution if the student does not wish to earn this additional credential. Students may speak with their faculty advisor in the Social Work and Human Services AAS degree program for more information about LCDC certification and course work.
- ***Courses completed as part of the AAS SWHS:** Students must earn an overall GPA of 2.75 to be eligible for admission into the Social Work major at UC. Students must complete all courses that apply to the Social Work major

with a grade of “C” or higher at CSCC. Students should complete STAT 1350 for their math requirement for the AAS SWHS degree. Students should also complete HIST 1152 for HUM XXXX in the AAS SWHS to satisfy general education and major core requirements.

- The program can be completed entirely online through the University of Cincinnati. The major course work is designed to be completed PART-TIME over 10 semesters (including summer). However, students may need to be enrolled full-time depending upon what course work is remaining when the student enrolls in UC.
- ****General Education:** A portion of the UC General Education requirement for the bachelor’s degree is fulfilled with the AAS Social work and Human Services degree course work as directed on page 1 of this document. The AAS Social Work and Human Services degree will be transferred almost in its entirety and applied to the bachelor’s degree at UC. However, students will have to complete additional general education courses for UC’s general education and major requirements. **These courses must be completed before beginning the Social Work major advanced course at UC.** Equivalent courses for these requirements may be completed at Columbus State, if desired, or completed at UC. **PLEASE NOTE:** Students who use federal financial aid funding to cover the costs of their course work may not receive funding for any courses not listed in the AAS Social Work and Human Services degree program including these additional courses. Before registering for any additional course work at CSCC, students should consult with a CSCC financial aid advisor and an UC program academic advisor to discuss appropriate and optimal course selections for general education.
- Students must complete a total of 120 credit hours and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 to earn the bachelor’s degree once enrolled at UC.
