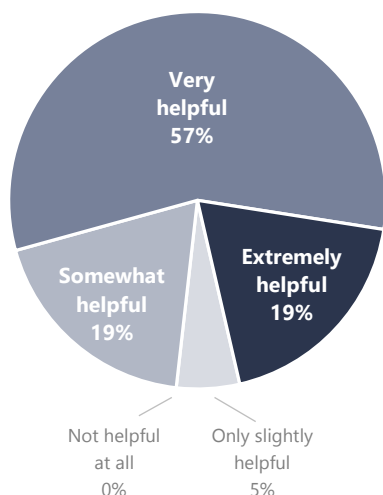


Columbus State – LET Career Readiness Program – Resume Writing Workshop

Pre-post quiz and feedback survey

37 students completed a pre-post quiz and a post-workshop evaluation survey

Most students gave the workshop an overall rating of "Very helpful" or "Extremely helpful"



What students learned that was most helpful

- What not to do or include (12 students)
- How to write a summary of qualifications (7)
- Which fonts to use or not use (6)
- What ATS is and how to circumvent (5)
- How quickly employers review resumes (4)
- How to create a better resume (4)
- What experience as skills to include (3)
- How to organize a resume (2)

Changes students recommended

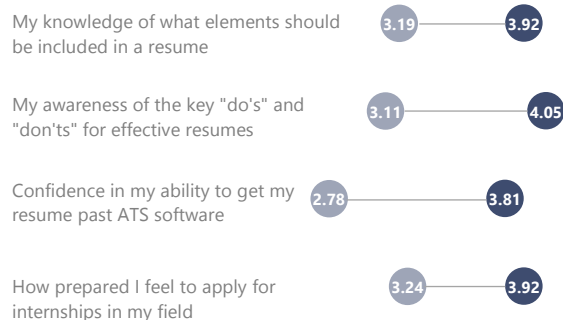
- More time – slower pace (3)
- Other (7)
 - Schedule sooner to allow more time for resume review
 - Less audience participation
 - Provide templates
 - Put ATS on a slide
 - Different time
 - More desk space for computer
 - Water fountain

11 students recommended changing nothing!

Every student's test score improved from pre to post workshop with an average increase of 54%



Mean self-ratings* for each learning objective improved from pre to post workshop



* On a scale with 1=Very low, 2=Low, 3=Medium, 4=High, 5=Very high
