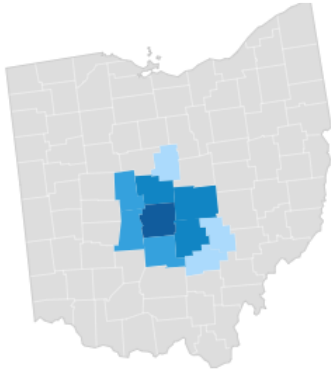

Columbus Region: Logistics Market Overview



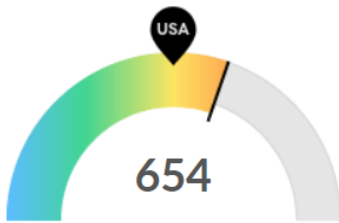

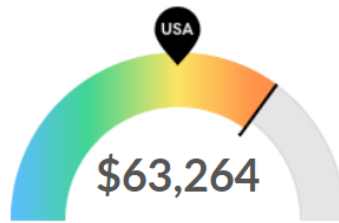

Average Hiring Competition Over a Deep Supply of Regional Talent



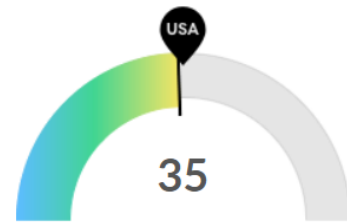
Jobs

The cost for talent is high in Columbus, OH. The national median salary for Industrial Engineering Technicians is \$55,453, while you'll pay \$63,264 here.



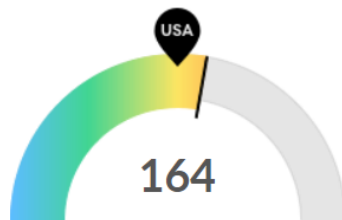
Job Posting Demand

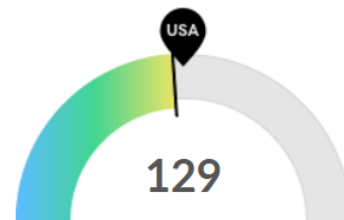
Demographics

Retirement Risk Is High, While Overall Diversity Is High



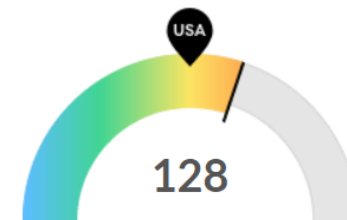
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Columbus, OH. The national average for an area this size is 140* employees 55 or older, while there are 164 here.

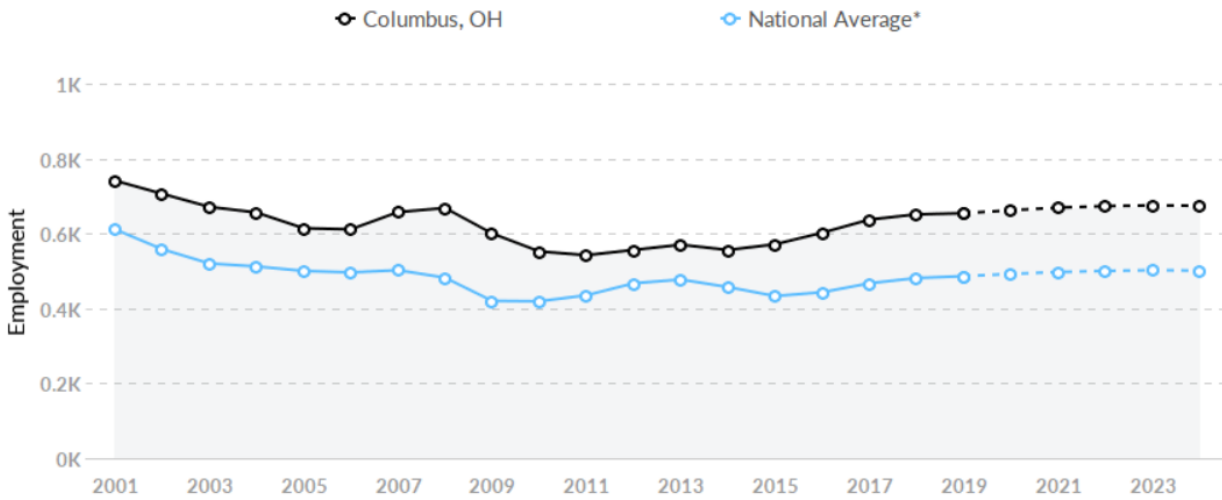

Regional Employment Is Higher Than the National Average

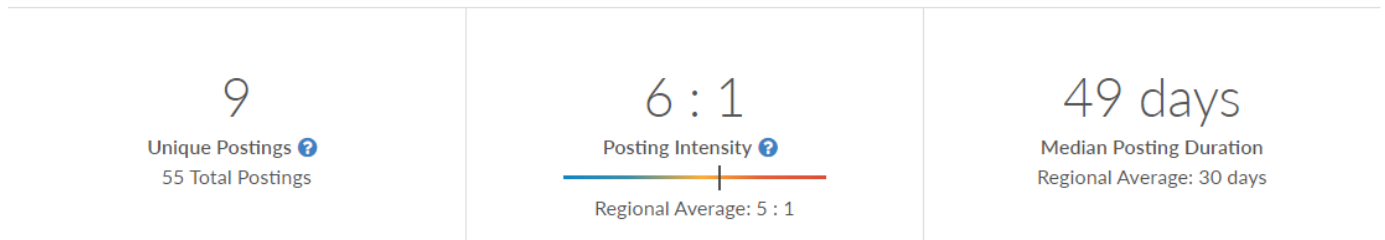
The regional vs. national average employment helps you understand if the supply of Industrial Engineering Technicians is a strength or weakness for Columbus, OH, and how it is changing relative to the nation. An average area of this size would have 486* employees, while there are 653 here. This higher than expected supply may make it easier to find candidates. The gap between expected and actual employment is expected to remain roughly the same over the next 5 years.

18% Past Growth (2014 - 2019) 3% Projected Growth (2019 - 2024)



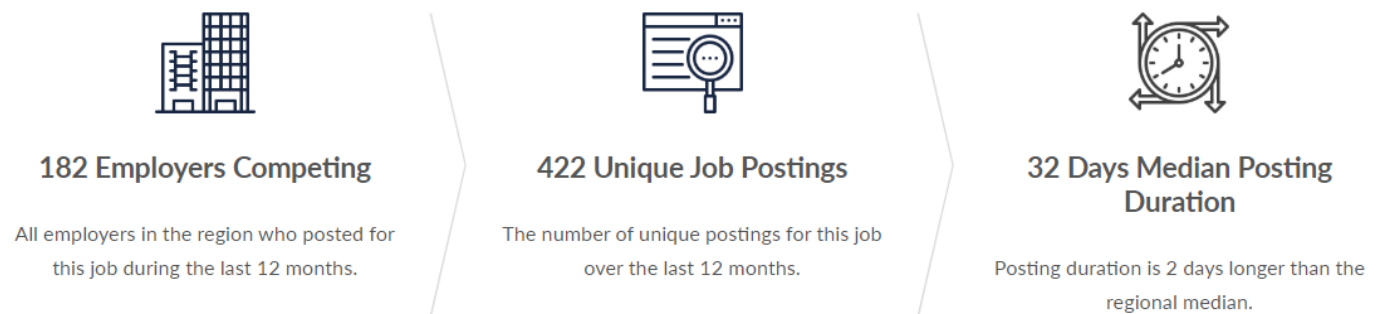
