

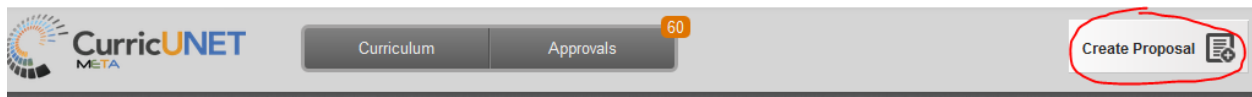
CurricUNET – Program Deactivation

To END a program you must create a Program Deactivation template which will be routed through the curriculum review and approval process.

Please provide a “Justification for Program Deactivation” that explains what data and resources were used to determine that deactivation was appropriate. Additionally, include what year and semester you would like to have the program removed from the Admission Application and when (year and semester) you would like the program to officially be closed.

Remember that you will need to provide a description (attachment) of how you have mapped any new or existing students through to completion. This mapping should allow you to account for all students with an “Active” program of study that matches the one you are deactivating or any certificates that are a part of the degree.

If you are deactivating certificates and a degree, then you will need to complete a “Deactivation” for each program of study you are intending to end.



Create Proposal

This page allows you to create a new draft proposal. While in draft state, the proposal is only available to you and any co-contributors you add.

Once all required fields are complete, the proposal can be submitted for review. A proposal can be deleted prior to launch. While under review, changes to a proposal are only allowed when requested by a reviewer.
