Viewing Courses and Programs in CurricUNET

Once you have logged in you will be on the Course Landing Page




Remember that the tool is a database and what you are looking at is a dashboard so you must remember any time you do a search to tell the tool what you are looking for and then hit the "Search" button.

Key Items to remember for a Course Search


The system will set itself on "My Courses" which allows you to find courses that you have originated.

Switch the radio button to "My Institution" if you are interested in finding any course.

The Tool allows you to do a Subject search, you must click in the box beside the subject you are interested in viewing.



It will allow you to search on the status of a course



You can search for an actual course that you know the alpha and numeric for



Or you can do a search using multiple items – just remember to hit the "SEARCH" button once you are ready to pull the data.

Key Items to remember for a Program Search


You can switch from Courses to Programs searches using the drop down on the "Curriculum" button.




Once in the Programs search area remember your "My Programs" vs. "My Institution" selection



Again, you have options to search by, the first being the status of the program




You can search by certificate or degree



You can search by the Organization the program falls under



You can search by a word in the title



Or you can search by a combination of fields – just remember that the narrower you define your search you must be spot on or you won't find what you are looking for.
