<u>Courses Taught</u> - List of courses taught over the past two years including:

- Course Name and Number
- Semester Taught

<u>Course Units of Instruction</u> - Two examples of Course Syllabi from the past two years demonstrating:

- o Course Description
- o Learning Outcomes
- o Methods of Instruction
- o Grading Weight
- o Assignments
- Unit of Instruction (Over the term taught)
- *Note:* It is not necessary to include college or department policies standard to all course syllabi.

<u>Grade Spreadsheets</u> - Two spreadsheets of grades awarded for any two courses from the past two years. Spreadsheets should include:

- Course Name and Number
- o Semester Taught
- o Instructor Name
- o Assignment Weights
- o Individual Student Assignment Points Awarded
- o Final Letter Grades Awarded
- Note: Please redact student names or other private information.

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<u>Course Evaluations</u> - Minimum two Course Evaluations from the past two years. May include:

- Face to Face Student Evaluations with <u>ALL</u> student comments
- Student Web Course Evaluations
- Instructor Observations by Peers or Administrators

<u>Assessment Examples</u> - Minimum two examples of any types of Assessments from the past two years with Narrative Cover Sheet identifying the following information:

- o Name of the Assessment
- o Course
- Purpose of the Assessment

Assessment examples may include:

- Assignment Guidelines
- o Grading Rubrics Utilized
- Tests Utilized
- Examples of Student Work (with names redacted)
- Examples of Student Submissions with Feedback (with names redacted)

Other Documentation of Teaching Excellence - Open category.

May include any other types of examples that demonstrate continuous improvement and excellence in teaching *from the past two years only*.

Examples may include (but are not limited to):

- Screen Shots of Web Course Content such as Camtasia Relay Videos, Announcements, Discussion Boards, etc.
- o E-Mails to students explaining concepts
- E-Mails from students commending the nominee.
- Powerpoints or other presentations created by the nominee
- Examples of the use of technology in the classroom.
- Examples of collaborative learning activities used in the classroom.
