Campus Perks:

Fitness Center Access: Located in Delaware Hall, the Fitness Center's hours are Monday & Wednesday: 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Tuesday & Thursday: 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Friday: 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Facilities in the college's gym include a weight room and facilities for basketball and volleyball. Free wellness classes including yoga, HIIT (High Intensity Interval Training), Kettlebell Express, Total Body Conditioning and Self Defense Training are also offered at our Columbus Campus.

Our Fitness Center located at the Delaware Campus is open Monday-Friday: 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (*Hours subject to change. Check website for hours).

Free Parking: Free parking is available to all non-student employees in any of the parking lots and garage on campus.

<u>Massage Clinic</u>: Employees are eligible to take advantage of full-body massages offered by the Massage Therapy program for a minimal fee.

Bookstore Discount: A 10% discount is granted to all Columbus State employees at the DX Bookstore (excluding computer software and massage tables). Check out what specials are happening right now at the Bookstore!

<u>Library</u>: Employees are eligible to take advantage of library circulation privileges, use of the A/V video equipment, computer services, etc.

<u>Employee Resource Groups</u>: Employee Resource Groups (ERGs) are employee-led voluntary groups organized around common interests, characteristics, or affiliations; these groups were created to foster a sense of belonging and are integral to Columbus State's commitment to advance workplace diversity and inclusion, facilitate networking and connections, and promote professional development. Columbus State's ERG groups include African/African American, Caregivers, Faith in Parenting, LGBTQIA+ and Womens.

Education Perks:

<u>Fee Waivers</u>: Columbus State will waive 100% of appropriate instructional fees for full-time employees who take degree credit courses. Our program also covers spouses and dependents, waiving 75% of appropriate instructional fees.
