- 1. Welcome Ruey Bruce welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. Approval of Minutes June 25, 2021 meeting (attached) (5 min)

- 3. COVID-19 Planning Update Ruey (10 min)
  - The COVID-19 environment continues to rapidly change.
  - College goal to increase enrollment caps to pre-pandemic numbers with faculty encouraged to speak with chairs if a lower enrollment is needed; College is committed to working cooperatively with faculty on this.
  - Beginning AU21, masks only required for non-vaccinated using the honor system.
  - Vending options will be available autumn semester, but conversation continues regarding what effect a less dense population will have on availability.
- 4. Council Business (15 min)
  - 1. Faculty Fellow Accreditation Cathy
    - Marty shared with FFs that this position will be posted soon and will begin AU21
  - 2. Student E-mail Forwards Amy
    - Amy reached out to Heather Crites, systems administrator for the College, who addressed the faculty concerns that Blackboard announcements and emails are not forwarded to students' personal accounts; Heather said that this is not the case, and she shared the results of the testing that verified Blackboard announcements/e-mails are forwarded properly.
    - Amy and Jorie S. requested that faculty reach out to them if issues related to this occur in the future.

- 3. Shared Governance Process Consultant Cathy
  - The College has hired Kim Henderson (formerly Kim Hall and chief of staff at the College) as an outside consultant to review current shared governance process.
  - FFs will keep the Council updated on developments and encourage participation in this process.

  - Thanks to those Co-Chairs who have already held discussions with their committees and posted to Teams. Encourage all to participate and to continue the discussion as we move forward in this environment.
- 5. Outgoing Co-Chairs

  - Cathy was recognized for her dedication and contributions as Academic Council Co-Faculty Fellow; Mary Lewis was welcomed as the faculty member who is replacing Cathy beginning autumn semester.
- 5. AC Committee Updates
  - 1. Diversity & Inclusion Committee Name Change (Reuel)
    - D&I Committee will be renamed Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.
    - Committee concerned that no staff have been added to DEI area since VP-DEI hired; discussion regarding options for revisiting DEI recommendations that were previously submitted and remain unaddressed.
  - 2. Delaware Campus Committee (Ben)
    - Currently, there is no Academic Leader for the Delaware Campus (DC).
    - Committee recommended an Associate Dean for DC only due to increasing number of programs and faculty at DC; have not received feedback from administration yet.
