- 5) AACC Pathways (Academic Pathways Committee)

Went to pathways institute. We were one of 30 schools for a three-year (2015-2018) training timeframe. F/u on Achieving the Dream. Creating guided pathways. Big themes/Problems: Low graduation, too long to complete, taking non-applicable courses, high cost & too much debt. Try to get students more guided through college. Less "swirl", or wandering around.

- 6) Task Force Updates (Judy Anderson)
 - a. Eight-Week Task Force Includes any non-standard length class. Meeting next week.
 - b. Competency-Based Learning Judy and Patricia Allen examining. Borrow from Western Governors University, (which is not new wgu.edu founded in 1997).
- 7) Honors by contract option for students (Honors Committee) Current cohort is 197. Have some honors courses. Looking at Honors by Contract. Students inside the honors program to get honors credit for a non-honors course. Currently: Students need 15 hours of honors courses to graduate "with honors". And there are not 15 hours of courses available for some of the degrees. Possible options to make a non-honors course have honors by contract: Additional projects, harder/deeper exams. Four-year schools and other cc's doing this. Still looking at defining process and contract with student, etc. Looking into possible compensation for faculty. Challenge with Delaware. (Vote next meeting f/u items underlined, and members can email other issues to Rita.)
