

COLUMBUS STATE BOOKSTORE APPOINTMENT GUIDELINES

Thank you for scheduling your appointment with the Columbus State Bookstore. To ensure the health and safety of our campus community, please be aware of a few important requirements related to COVID-19 before you come onto campus.

You should not proceed to campus for your appointment if any of the following pertain to you:

1. Have a fever greater than 100 degrees or have any symptoms related to COVID-19 such as sore throat, cough, headache, or new loss of taste or smell on the date of your appointment.
2. You are currently scheduling a COVID-19 test or waiting for test results for yourself due to a known exposure or symptoms.

When you get to campus, please be aware of the following:

- 1) You **MUST** wear a facial covering at all times while in the campus facilities or if you are not able to achieve the social distancing (as posted on campus) from another individual when outside.
- 2) You **MUST** follow social distancing requirements as posted while on campus with anyone who is not from your household.
- 3) You **MUST** practice proper hygiene:
 - a. Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer (with at least 60% alcohol), especially after coughing or sneezing and before smoking or eating.
 - b. Use cough and sneeze etiquette: cough and sneeze into your inner elbow or arm to reduce droplets. If you contaminate your hands with a cough or sneeze, immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer if hand washing is not available.
 - c. Do not shake hands with, touch or hug individuals who are not from your household.
- 4) Appointments are being handled on an individual basis for students only, so please **do not** bring visitors with you to the Bookstore.
