Your CSCC email address MUST be used in order to gain full access!

Update an existing copy of R&W

- Open Read&Write
- Click on the "i" icon at the top right of the RW toolbar
- Choose "About Read&Write"
- Click "Check for updates"
- A download manager box will open
 - Click "Check for updates" button
 - the program should begin updates automatically upon opening but will require you to restart the computer.
 - OR you will see a message saying "You are on the latest version..." appear indicating it is already up to date.

Update an existing copy of Lockdown Browser/Respondus Monitor

(only if required by instructor for testing)

- Open Respondus LockDown Browser
- Select "i" from the toolbar (Windows) or "About" (Mac).
- Select Check for Newer Version
- Follow the on-screen instructions to download and run the patch


1. Click on the dotted box in the top blue toolbar.
