The award notification assumes full-time enrollment at CSCC. Awards may be cancelled or reduced if enrollment drops below full-time at any point in a semester. Refer to the table below for the specific enrollment requirements of most common financial aid programs. **Plan to enroll in summer?** Summer financial aid eligibility is based on the amount of aid unused from the previous Autumn and/or Spring semesters. Federal Financial Aid regulations require each course a student is registered for be part of the student's Plan of Study in order for that course to be counted as "Federal Student Aid Eligible". Federal Student Aid eligibility calculation cannot include classes that do not count toward the student's degree or certificate.
